

Trails

Quarry Trail

Follow the old rail bed to the quarry where the stone cutters of East Sioux Falls worked.

- Approximate walking time: 16 minutes
- Difficulty: Moderate, primitive

House Trail

Veer northeast from the Quarry Trail to discover what remains of a house that was abandoned years ago.

- Approximate walking time: 5 minutes
- Difficulty: Moderate, primitive

Perry Trail

Explore the Perry Nature Area. Highlights include the creek and historic bur oak—over 200 years old!

- Approximate walking time: 11 minutes
- Difficulty: Easy, accessible, moderate hill

Floodplain Trail

Take a relaxing walk by the river's edge.

- Approximate walking time: 14 minutes
- Difficulty: Easy, primitive

Railbed-River Trail

Follow the old rail bed to a river overlook.

- Approximate walking time: 17 minutes
- Difficulty: Easy, primitive

Formal Gardens Path

Enjoy a stroll through the formal gardens.

- Approximate walking time: 11 minutes
- Difficulty: Easy, accessible
